Market-Related Report:

- How far is the market?
- When and where is the market or the hot market held?
- Number of people gathered in the market.
- What is sold and at what price? Any difference in between the village and the market prices?

• Identify the primary sellers, whether they are farmers or traders.

Panchayat Raj Institution Meeting:

- Document all topics and points discussed in the meeting.
- Provide your observations and evaluations of the meeting.

Water Resource Report:

- The number of available water resources in the village.
- Community uses of these water resources, such as using ponds for bathing, animal drinking, fish production, and irrigation.
- Describe which water sources farmers use for irrigation.
- Drinking water source.
- How does the village manage dirty or rainwater?
- Any other water-related challenges.

Self-Evaluation by the CRP:

- Can you fulfill the CRP's responsibilities?
- Mention which tasks you found easier and more comfortable to perform.
- Highlight tasks that you found challenging, describe?
- Mention any skills or knowledge areas where you feel you need further training or assistance.
